### ARTICLES IN ENCYCLOPEDIAS

- Signed Article:** James Morris, "Mongols," in *Dictionary of the Middle Ages*, 2<sup>nd</sup> ed.
- Unsigned Article:** *Columbia Encyclopedia*, 5<sup>th</sup> ed., s.v. "mongols".

### Turabian Footnotes Subsequent References

Once a work has been cited in complete form, later references to the work are shortened. When references to the same work follow each other with no intervening references the Latin term *Ibid* is used in place of the author's name and title.

Books:

- One Author: Franklin, *George Washington*, 54 or *Ibid.*, 54 [or another page number]  
Multiple authors: Smith, *American Culture*, 105 or *Ibid.*, 105 [or another page number]

Articles in Encyclopedias:

- Signed article: Morris, "Mongols" or *Ibid.*  
Unsigned article: *Columbia Encyclopedia*, "mongols" or *Ibid*

Articles in Periodicals:

- Signed article: Jackson, "Running down," 180 or *Ibid.*, 180 [or another page number]  
Unsigned article: "Running down," 180 or *Ibid.*, 180 [or another page number]

Electronic Resources:

- Web Page: Library of Congress. "Jackie Robinson." *American Memory* or *Ibid.*  
Signed article: Thomas, "Wales: Land of Mines", 62 or *Ibid.*, 62 [or another page number]  
Unsigned article: "Another Campus Drug Raid", sec 1 A or *Ibid.* [or another page number]
